A MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

A feeling of safety . . .

If you are at all like me, there have been several times over the last couple of years when you have needed to slow down, give yourself a chance to look around, and decide what is truly happening in the world and why it is important. It seems like people are constantly telling us what we should be thinking and how we should be feeling about this or that. For a while, all the focus seemed to be on the change in government leadership and the all-consuming pandemic. Now, attention has shifted to the unrest in parts of Europe and the implications it is having on the global economy. Once that gets cleared up, I'm sure there will be some other topic or event that the media will tell us we need to prioritize and be concerned about. I've often wondered what it would be like to live through these situations without a Christian upbringing and belief system. I think it would be terrifying.

It's been nearly 50 years since I graduated from RCS and I still occasionally see former classmates. They seem to be doing well and leading happy, fulfilling lives. I have to think you might find some common themes if you talked with them and took a deeper dive into their life journeys. I am not suggesting the road has been smooth for all RCS alumni. I am sure there are stories of hardship, pain, and trial that virtually any of these people can share. We all know that being a Christian doesn't mean life will not throw you some curve balls. Our current world situation is a good example. As we move from pandemic to endemic, we are all feeling a bit drained and, to some extent, uncertain.

Through it all there is one word that we have heard a lot lately. That word is "safe". Goodbye and farewell have been replaced by "stay safe" and "be safe". Politicians and news anchors justify actions in the name of public safety. I don't think believers have the same ideas about safety as those who have not yet come to Christ. Being safe has risen to be the number one priority for many. In reality, if we are honest with ourselves, we discover that obsession with safety can have unintended consequences. There needs to be a balance as we decide for ourselves where we stand on the issue of being safe.

RCS teaches children that nothing can happen to them without the will of God. They graduate and leave the school knowing that God is always with them and will never leave their side, no matter what. RCS alumni have the gift of knowing a level of safety that goes beyond anything we can find on earth. I can't tell you how many times over these many years I have wondered why something is happening and have always come back to feeling better with the knowledge that God is with me and that "He's got the whole world in his hands". Little did I know when I walked out those RCS doors so many years ago that I had been given a gift of this knowledge that would keep giving to me for the rest of my life.

For all these reasons and so many more, I want to thank our supporters for your steadfast backing of the Rochester Christian School Foundation. Many people have contributed to this effort over the years by serving on the RCSF board, donating time, donating money, and including the Foundation in their prayer life. We thank God for his leading and guiding of these efforts and for the people he placed in our path at just the right time.



A MESSAGE FROM MICHELLE SELVAGGIO, RCS PRINCIPAL

Most of the activities that had to be cancelled last year due to COVID have returned to the building, from volleyball and other sports, to the Arts Gala, to field trips, to parent volunteers coming in to help with class projects. By God's Grace and the incredibly hard work of our faculty and staff, our students are thriving. Our enrollment is up a bit from last year, and based on the number of building tours and

applications coming in so far, we are planning for increased enrollment next year.

The enthusiasm with which our students are meeting these challenges and their true hearts of service toward those in need are exciting to see.
